### SEASIDE CITIES OF DEL MAR & LA JOLLA

8/15 (Afternoon) (Free Trip)

Be sure to join us on our trip to Del Mar and La Jolla Cove. We will first visit Del Mar Plaza with upscale shops overlooking the ocean. Then it's off to La Jolla is an upscale hamlet of hotels, boutiques and galleries on Prospect Street. This tiny beach nook, part of the San Diego La Jolla Underwater Park Ecological Reserve, is sheltered by picturesque cliffs and offers stunning views of the Pacific Ocean in an intimate setting.

### THE "CROWN CITY" CORONADO

8/14 Morning (Free Trip)

Coronado is a small "island" town in San Diego Bay, approximately 7.4 square miles in size, connected to the City of San Diego by the San Diego-Coronado Bridge and to the City of Imperial Beach to the south. We will be visiting the famous hotel Del Coronado, walk along the beautiful beach and you may choose to have lunch on your own as a special treat. Opened in 1888, it is the crown of Coronado! A guided 1 hour bus tour of the island is included. Downtown Coronado boasts unique shops and many restaurants serving residents and visitors. And their award-winning beach, recently ranked second best in the country by the Travel Channel.

### SAN DIEGO ZOO

8/17 Day Trip (\$44.00)

Home to more than 4,000 rare and endangered animals representing more than 800 species and subspecies, the San Diego Zoo is a world famous conservation organization where visitors view exotic animals in habitat environments. Zoo guests may view rare giant pandas, koalas, reptiles and many more interesting species. Besides an extensive collection of birds, reptiles and mammals, it also maintains its grounds as an arboretum. Don't miss this national treasure!

### SAN DIEGO HARBOR CRUISE & SEAPORT VILLAGE

8/13 Morning & Afternoon (\$29)

Enjoy a 2 hour San Diego Harbor Cruise and see San Diego from a different point of view, that you cannot see on land. Visit Seaport Village and the Maritime Museum, and the Embarcadero just west of downtown, it is a remarkably clean and attractive shopping area. Lots to do, and lots to see!
