TOUR OF SAN DIEGO

7/12, 7/26 Morning (Free Trip)

Three and a half hour guided bus tour of San Diego. Visit all the interesting sights of this exciting City. Make notes on those attractions you want to return to.

BALBOA PARK

7/13, 7/27 Afternoon (Free Trip)

Balboa Park, the nation's largest urban park is made up of more than 1,000 acres and offers fifteen museums, various gardens, arts and international culture associations, making it a place that offers something historical, horticultural, educational and recreational for everyone. You will have the choice to visit up to 4 museums on our afternoon trip.

SEASIDE CITIES OF DEL MAR & LA JOLLA

8/3 (Afternoon) (Free Trip)

Be sure to join us on our trip to Del Mar and La Jolla Cove. We will first visit Del Mar Plaza with upscale shops overlooking the ocean. Then it's off to La Jolla is an upscale hamlet of hotels, boutiques and galleries on Prospect Street. This tiny beach nook, part of the San Diego La Jolla Underwater Park Ecological Reserve, is sheltered by picturesque cliffs and offers stunning views of the Pacific Ocean in an intimate setting.

THE "CROWN CITY" CORONADO

7/17, 7/31 Morning (Free Trip)

A guided 1 hour bus tour of the island is included. Coronado is a small "island" town in San Diego Bay, approximately 7.4 square miles in size, connected to the City of San Diego by the San Diego-Coronado Bridge and to the City of Imperial Beach to the south. We will be visiting the famous hotel Del Coronado, walk along the beautiful beach and you may choose to have lunch on your own as a special treat. Opened in 1888, it is the crown of Coronado! Downtown Coronado boasts unique shops and many restaurants serving residents and visitors. And their award-winning beach, recently ranked second best in the country by the Travel Channel. On 7/17 we will also be visiting La Jolla in the afternoon.

SAN DIEGO ZOO

7/18, 8/1 Day Trip (\$44.00)

Home to more than 4,000 rare and endangered animals representing more than 800 species and subspecies, the San Diego Zoo is a world famous conservation organization where visitors view exotic animals in habitat environments. Zoo guests may view rare giant pandas, koalas, reptiles and many more interesting species. Besides an extensive collection of birds, reptiles and mammals, it also maintains its grounds as an arboretum. Don't miss this national treasure!

SAN DIEGO HARBOR CRUISE & SEAPORT VILLAGE

7/16, 7/30 Morning & Afternoon (\$29)

Enjoy a 2 hour San Diego Harbor Cruise and see San Diego from a different point of view, that you cannot see on land. Then visit Seaport Village and the Maritime Museum, and the Embarcadero just west of downtown, it is a remarkably clean and attractive shopping area. Lots to do, and lots to see!

SEAPORT VILLAGE

7/16, 7/30 Morning (FREE) (WITHOUT HARBOR CRUISE)

Just west of downtown, it is a remarkably clean and attractive shopping area. Visit Seaport Village and the Maritime Museum, and the Embarcadero. Lots to do, and lots to see!

OLD TOWN

7/24 Morning/Afternoon (Free Trip)

This area was the site of the first Spanish settlement in California, known as the Pueblo de San Diego. A plaza was laid out here in the 1820's. It was the center of San Diego until 1872, when the city's focus moved to the current downtown area. In 1968, Old Town became a State Historic Park. The few surviving original buildings were restored. The area now is now a touristy pedestrian haven with many mexican shops.

ROBIN AND THE 7 HOODS (THE OLD GLOBE THEATER)

7/15 Evening (\$49)

A world premiere, Broadway-bound musical comedy that takes you back to that sexy era in pop culture where "Mad Men" reigned supreme, martinis flowed freely and the songs ruled the night. It's the Robin Hood legend with a early sixties spin.
